

FAQs FOR RE-OPENING FACILITY FOR IN-HOUSE WORSHIP

- This is ***Phase I***— other phases will come as circumstances allow.
- An instructional video, *What to Expect at In-House Worship*, will be launched on Peace2U and our social platforms, beginning next Wednesday (9/23), that will help walk individuals through the protocols and procedures that have been put in place. It helps everyone to know what they can expect as you navigate the facility as well as the worship spaces.
- The service times in *Phase I* will be:
 - 8:30am [in the Sanctuary] — Traditional Service
 - 10:30am [in the ConneXions Center] — Contemporary Service
 - 10:30am LiveStream Service ... please note the NEW TIME
[this LiveStream Service will be a *live broadcast* of the 10:30am Contemporary Service]
- Because both worship venues have limited seating that have been drastically lowered due to protocols we will begin our first weeks with a **SIGN UP / RSVP** process.
 - **On Monday, September 28 an online link will be emailed out (also made available through Peace's social platforms)** whereby you can sign yourself/your family up to attend a service for that next Sunday. (Peace will continue this process, weekly, as long as needed.)
 - For your reference:
 - the Sanctuary will accommodate approximately 60-65 worshippers per Sunday
 - the ConneXions Center will accommodate approximately 100 worshippers per Sunday.

UPON ARRIVAL:

- Check-in / sign-in as entering the building. This is for health and safety of everyone and allows contact tracing in the case of an infection being reported.
- Masks/facecoverings must be worn by everyone 3 years and older while in the Peace facility.
- Hands should be sanitized as individuals enter the building. Hand sanitizing stations are positioned throughout the building for everyone's convenience.
- Entrance Doors will be propped-**open** for your convenience and safety. (Other doors will remain closed/locked.)
- At all entrances to worship spaces (Sanctuary and ConneX Center) baskets with prefilled communion components will be available and staffed. Members/visitors will be invited to take one with them to their seat. Communion will be taken in your seat at the appropriate time during the service.
- At all entrances to worship spaces, baskets for offering will be available. Offertory Baskets will **not** be passed at this time.
- Worship Bulletins will not be dispensed.
 - Bulletins will be maintained online ahead of service date and can be printed by individuals and brought to the church, if desired.
 - A table with a QR code that can be downloaded to a phone will also be available for those who wish to follow along electronically.
- FYI: Hymnals / Bibles have been removed from the worship spaces at this time.
- Singing with hymns/songs is **not** recommended. Members will be asked to prayerfully enjoy hymns/songs as they're presented by singing leaders that day.
- Water fountains and Coffee stations are not available in the building at this time.
- Nursery is not available at this time.
- Children's Ministry programming is **not** available **in the building** at this time but J.A.M. can be followed online through the website just established. Check out the Children's Ministry facebook page for details.

- This reopening for worship doesn't mean the building is open to all group meetings. Groups will be assessed for size (i.e. numbers usually in attendance at meeting) to determine if an appropriately-size space is available. Where/when applicable, staff will hold protocol training sessions with group leaders to instruct on the new protocol guidelines.
 - Please respect our staff who will help serve as directors of the process

We need to be open to this changing again should the county experience an uptick in COVID reporting.
